

## Student Awards Regulations and Process

Alfaisal University has embraced a vision of academic excellence manifesting in the recruitment of distinguished faculty and staff, and promising students. The university has achieved remarkable success in four years. Alfaisal is a student centered one and it aims at promoting the best of its students. Therefore, it will launch four Awards categories to encourage students to be global active citizens and distinguished leaders, besides four Recognition Awards for the appreciation of the active students.

### **The Eligibility Criteria:**

- 1- Demonstrate outstanding overall participation in different activities.
- 2- Have a free academic record of violation of university's rules.
- 3- Student must have a minimum GPA 2.5
- 4- Must be a fulltime student
- 5- Pass 20 credited hours

### **Nomination Process:**

1. At the beginning of six week of spring semester, dean of student affairs invites students to apply for the award through their colleges, associations and clubs.
2. The college dean, head of the association or clubs advisors should submit within two weeks a written account of the student's participation in activities and his/her role in each. No self-nominations will be accepted
3. The Student Awards Committee is responsible for evaluating nominees and selecting the winners' nominees.

**The Student Awards Committee is chaired by the dean of student affairs, and its members are:**

1. SLC Chairperson,
2. Assistant dean of student affairs,
3. Two faculty members nominated by CoD.

### **The Awards Categories**

#### **Most Outstanding Active Student Award**

This award goes to students who have exceeded expectations through hard work, dedication, leadership and professionalism and have provided extraordinary support to clubs/organizations during various events. The awardees receive an SR 5,000 Cash. This award is limited to 4 students per academic year for both male and female students.

#### **Most Outstanding Community Services Volunteer Award**

Students are selected for this award based on their

Exemplary record of serving humanity and in making a difference in the life of the underprivileged. The awardees receive an SR 5,000 Cash. This award is limited to 4 individuals or teams per academic year. If a team of students wins the award, award value will be distributed equally between team members.

#### **Most Outstanding Student Leader Award**

Students selected for this award have made significant contributions and exhibited leadership at Alfaisal and the community in general. They have exceeded expectations with their hard work and dedication during various events/projects. The awardees receive an SR 5,000 Cash or tuition remission for the following academic year. This award is limited to 4 students per academic year for both male and female students.

#### **Most Outstanding Athlete Award**

The most outstanding athletes are honored for their contributions to Alfaisal sports team/programs, especially those who exhibit noteworthy leadership qualities. The awardees receive an SR 5,000 Cash or tuition remission for the following academic year. This award is limited to 4 individuals or teams per academic year. If a team of students wins the award, award value will be distributed equally between team members.

#### **Activities Award**

Club members are recognized for providing extraordinary support in the planning and implementation of clubs/organizations activities during the previous academic year.

#### **Community Service Award**

This award honors students who have made significant contributions to Community Services in general through impartial outstanding volunteerism and community outreach programs. Recipients must be in good academic standing with the university.

#### **Student Council Award**

This award is given to the board members of the Student Council for their effort and service in supporting Alfaisal students in different tasks or events.

#### **Athletics Award**

Team members are honored for their contribution, hard work and achievement in various sporting events/programs.
